Directions: Directions: Take exit 743 from the AP-7 motorway which is signed for Los Montesinos. Head towards Algorfa until you arrive at a roundabout signed 'Golf'. From here you can follow the signs leading you to the course.

Overview: A recent addition to the Costa Blanca golf world, this Pepe Gancedo designed course has been laid out in the Arizona style, with fantastic greens and large, palm-fringed fairways. Situated at the foot of Mount Escotera, the views are inspiring and as this course matures expect to see top tournaments scheduled.

Direction Directions: Located amongst the urbanisations of Sierra Altea, it's easy to find once you exit junction 64 of the AP-7. As you come into the village, follow the signs for Don Cayo, which take you up a steep incline where you will find the car park situated on your right-hand side.

Overview: A friendly, 9-hole course with a five-bay driving range, a welcoming restaurant and an intricate layout. Perfect for a quick knock after work or first thing in the morning and with the seaside town of Altea nearby you can head for a splash after your round.

Direction Directions: Take exit 17B off the AP-7 motorway and head for Alicante-Puerto. Keep to the right hand lane and take the first exit CV-86. Continue straight over two roundabouts and at the third roundabout take the left hand exit. Turn right at the next junction and continue for 200 metres. The entrance to the golf course is on the left.

Overview: Inaugurated in 2000, this intelligently designed course is renowned for its good-quality greens, tight fairways and well-positioned bunkers. If you are not accurate from the tee, you're in for a long round.

Direction Directions: You can spot the course very easily from the AP-7 motorway. Located next to the Terra Mítica and Terra Natura theme parks, simply take exit 68 and after the toll take a left at the first roundabout. Then veer off to the right along a dual carriageway which is dotted with splendid architectural roundabouts. The golf course entrance is the same as for the two 5-star hotels it shares its grounds with.

Overview: Designed by Nicklaus Design, the first 'true' Benidorm golf course is quickly becoming one of the best-known around the Costa Blanca. Stunning views let you gaze onto the Mediterranean and the skyscrapers of the famous holiday resort, while the Puig Campana mountain stands imperiously behind you. The championship Levante course sits adjacent to the more friendly 62-par Poniente 18.

Direction Directions: Driving from Calpe on the Calpe-Moraira coast road will bring you to the Pepe Sal supermarket. Take a left after here following the signs to the golf course, which is located in a residential area.

Overview: A gem of a 9-hole course, much-loved by the resident golfer. Spectacular views to the iconic Peñon de Ifach outcrop sitting in the Mediterranean. And quite a difficult little course due to its narrow fairways and hilly topography. Perfect for the hot summer months due to its shortness but don't expect any favours.

Directions: Directions: Part of the Marriot Denia complex and located near the village of Jesus Pobre, you will get there by exiting the AP-7 at junction 62, heading in the direction of Denia. Take a right to La Xara and Jesus Pobre.

Overview: A quality course designed by Juan de la Cuadra and José María Olazábal, this 18-hole beauty will have a further 9 holes added in the future. It's a demanding round, but one that provides great value for money. The on-site facilities are excellent and the adjacent Marriott hotel adds a splash of 5-star glamour.

Direction Directions: From Jávea town centre take the road heading toward Benitachell, where you will find the entrance to the course on your left-hand side.

Overview: This ever-popular 9-hole course has a true friendly feel, a bit like some of the local clubs back in the UK. Totally different to the big Murcia resort courses, but fantastic all the same. There has been talk of an upgrade to 18 holes ever since the last Queen died. It should happen, but don't hold your breath.

Direction Directions: Exit AP-7 signed Madrid to take the AP-31. Follow the road towards Area de Servicio, take the right turn past the old clubhouse to the new roundabout and make a left, driving alongside the course's new clubhouse on the right-hand side.

Overview: A gently-rolling landscape, this Roland Favrat course opened in 1999 and provides a nice test for all abilities. The front nine is wide and tree-lined, while the inward holes require more concentration and precision. Facilities include two putting greens and a 20-bay driving range.

Direction Directions: Exit the AP-7 motorway at junction 67 signed Jijona/Xixona and approximately 3km further on take a right signposted for Busot-Bonalba. You will travel on tree-lined roads through the course until you take a right into the clubhouse car park.

Overview: Awesome views over the Mediterranean and a well thought-out course layout make for a great day's golf at Bonalba. The added restaurant and spa facilities are top-quality and allow you to enjoy a bit of R&R to the full.

Direction Directions: Exit the AP-7 at junction 724 signposted Cartagena/Torrevieja. After the toll take the 763 junction for La Zenia. After a second toll take a left at the roundabout following the signs for San Miguel and Villamartin golf. Straight across the next 2 roundabouts you will pass Villamartin shopping plaza. At the end of this road turn left and follow the signs to the golf course.

Overview: If you love lush fairways and the aroma of fresh pine then Campoamor will meet all of your expectations. Designed by Carmelo Gracias, this 6,203-metre course is a great test, with six dog-leg holes and superb, expansive fairways.

Directions: Directions: Exit the AP-7 at junction 724 signposted Cartagena/Torrevieja. After the toll take the 763 junction for La Zenia. After the next toll take a right onto the N-332 heading in the direction of Cartagena. Exit at Castillo de Juan and follow the signs for approximately 3km.

Overview: The narrow fairways demand a fair degree of accuracy off the elevated tees. There's plenty of water and a fair few hazards which can make for a high-scoring round. Add to that some pretty quick greens and you will be doing well to play to your handicap.

Direction Directions: Exit the AP-7 at junction 724 signposted Cartagena/Torrevieja. After the toll take the 763 junction for La Zenia. After a second toll take a left at the roundabout following the signs for San Miguel and Villamartin golf. Straight across the next 2 roundabouts you will pass Villamartin shopping plaza. Carry on until you reach the course.

Overview: Opened in 1972, Villamartin is one of the oldest courses in the Comunidad de Valencian. Superb design and a great setting have allowed the course to host some prestigious events, one of which a certain Señor Olazábal won back in 1997 (Volvo Mediterranean Open). The course maturity adds a lot to the overall experience and its superb test means every club in your bag will be used as you do battle with a great competitor.

Direction Directions: From the AP-7 exit at Esther junction 770 or 774, depending from which direction you are travelling from. Then turn into the Orihuela Road and follow the signs for Lo Romero Golf.

Overview: A new addition to the region, having recently opened its doors this year. A great location and possessing an absolutely standout hole: the 18th has the green situated in a lake a la Sawgrass. Bring it on! Or should that be bring on the balls?

Overview: The great maestro Seve Ballesteros designed the course back in 1998 and the 10th anniversary celebrations are well-deserved for a club that really welcomes all who play there.

Direction Directions: Exit at junction 745 of the AP-7 (Torrevieja Norte) and head for Ciudad Quesada. Once in the urbanisation area follow the signs for the golf course.

Overview: Situated in a valley and nestling within a large residential complex, La Marquesa offers its visitors a friendly welcome. Some say this is a relatively easy test, but there is more to it than meets the eye. One of the longest, if not the longest, par 5's in the region gives you some food for thought.

Directions: Exit the C-1339 Murcia/Balsicas road from the AP-7. Continue for approximately 10km until you see El Valle Golf Resort on the right. Turn off at the sign and follow the road down to the main entrance.

Overview: Set in a natural desert valley with an expansive layout, the smart player will win out over the power player here. One of the Nicklaus Design courses that are an ever familiar sight in these parts; accuracy rather than sheer force will bring the greatest reward.

Direction: Take the AP-7 motorway in the direction of Murcia and exit onto the C-3319 Murcia/Balsicas road. Keep travelling for about 12km until you see Mosa Golf situated on your right. Take the slip road which will lead you into the resort complex.

Overview: One of the biggest resorts with 27 Championship holes, as well as a belter of a 9-hole par-3 Challenge Course. Set against an impressive backdrop, the landscape is akin to an Arizona-type course with desert cacti and rock fighting for prominence against the many plants that make the whole Mosa experience a joyful one.

Direction: Just before reaching Murcia, follow signs for the A-30 Murcia/Cartagena. After about 15 minutes exit for Roldan, Fuente Alamo and Balsapintada. At the end of the slip road turn right towards Fuente Alamo. Go straight over the next roundabout to Fuente Alamo. Turn right at the next roundabout and follow the signs.

Overview: At 6,724 metres this is currently the longest golf course in Spain. Constructed close to the village of Fuente Alamo, deep in the heart of Murcia country, it is an absolute delight to play this Dave Thomas Championship course. If you fancy competing against 84 bunkers and 8 lakes and love to be surrounded by quality everywhere you look, then head for the Hacienda.

Direction: Take the AP-7 and exit at junction 790, signposted Los Alcázares (centro). At the first roundabout take the third exit to Los Alcázares, where you will travel under the AP-7 motorway to another roundabout. Take the first exit, signposted to La Serena Golf. This runs alongside the AP-7. The entrance is located on your left-hand side.

Overview: "Water, water everywhere but not a drop to drink," remarked Coleridge's seafarer. At La Serena, a pretty flat course, the danger is most certainly of the liquid variety. It doesn't help when the Levante wind blows in either! A nice addition to the Murcia golfing world and only 5 minutes from the beaches of the Mar Menor.

Direction: Exit at junction 800 of the AP-7 onto the MU-312 towards La Manga. Follow this road for about 12km. As you pass a Cepsa petrol station, take the next exit, junction 13, to Los Belones, Portman and La Manga Club Resort. At the roundabout, take a right signposted Campo de Golf and follow the signs to La Manga Club.

Overview: What can you say? The resort that started it all is still at the top of the league. The three very different Championship courses offer particular tests to the golfer. The North asks - no, cries out - for precision while the West places an emphasis on putting with its super-fast greens. The South course is tight and can be unforgiving to those players who get a bit too ambitious from the tee.

Directions: Situated 12km inland from Mazarrón, you will get to the course via the new Cartagena/Vera motorway which virtually passes straight through the Camposol urbanisation, where the club is situated.

Overview: The addition of a new 9 holes to create an 18-hole course has definitely been worthwhile for Sensol. Although the back 9 is a better challenge than the older front 9, preparations are being made to upgrade the old greens to create a more cohesive course.

Direction Situated 10km north-west of Murcia. Heading towards the city on the C3319, join the A-30 motorway, direction Albacete. Continue around the city and exit at the junction signposted Molina de Segura. Turn right heading towards 'Urbanizaciones'. Follow the signs for a few minutes

Overview: A tough test for golfers of all abilities, this Dave Thomas designed course opened its doors in 1994 and has been a popular destination on most people's golfing itinerary ever since. The greens are not easy to read and the par-5 6th is pretty long and very demanding. The surrounding scenery is pleasant, with the varied trees and fauna making this a beautiful course to play.

Direction Take the AP-7 (Alicante to Cartagena) and exit onto the C-3319 signposted Murcia/Balsicas. Continue until you come to the Roldan junction. Come off at the first exit which is a service road. This runs parallel to the C-3319. Continue until you see the golf course entrance on the left.

Overview: A fantastic vista awaits those who decide to play the recently opened La Torre. The rich vegetation and towering palm trees make each round a genuinely enjoyable experience and the layout demands plenty of thought as you weave your way round the skillfully designed fairways.

Direction Exiting the AP-7 motorway at junction 786 (Los Alcázares Norte). You will notice the course as the slip road goes back over the AP-7. At the first roundabout turn right heading towards Los Alcázares. At the next roundabout take the first right and follow signs to Roda.

Overview: The ubiquitous Dave Thomas team have designed a Mediterranean classic at Roda. The flat stretch of land has been superbly contoured and the many lakes and detailed attention to tree and vegetation planting has resulted in one of the most attractive courses in the region. Add to that the opening of the brand-new clubhouse and you will find that golf at Roda simply cannot be beaten.

Direction From San Javier take the C-3319 Murcia/Balsicas road. Turn off at the Sucina exit and at the end of the slip road turn right. Continue straight on through Avileses towards Sucina. You will see the course on the left-hand side, but the main entrance is accessed from the next left turn.

Overview: Seve Ballesteros has been at the helm for the design and construction of this gem of a course. The greens provide a stern test for even the best putter as they are fast, and often with difficult pin positions. There will not be many high handicappers scoring under-par on this course due to its technical nature. However, that is no reason not to up the ante and show the course what you're made of!

Directions: Leave the AP-7 at junction 780-A (Sucina, MU-301, San Javier). Take the first exit at the roundabout continuing on the MU-301. Pass through the village of Sucina - immediately after the village take a sharp left and follow the road for about 2km where you will find the club on your left-hand side.

Overview: The latest arrival on the golfing landscape in Murcia and part of the brilliant Nicklaus Golf Trail, Riquelme will attract those who like the look and feel of an established setting. The greens are boldly contoured and offer a challenge in themselves, while the surrounding olive groves add to the rustic nature of the course.

Direction From the AP-7 motorway exit at junction 790, signposted Los Alcázares (centro). At the first roundabout take the first exit right towards Torre Pacheco. Keep heading straight towards Torre Pacheco until you see a Polaris World petrol station, then take the next right turn. The entrance is 500m down on the left.

Overview: Currently 9 holes but soon to be upgraded to 18, this spectacular offering from the Nicklaus Design team provides a relatively comfortable challenge, even to the high-handicap golfer. A diverse range of shots is still required to protect your score, but there won't be too much damage if you manage to steer clear of the water hazards.
